







IMPROVING PRIMARY HEALTH CARE IN CAMEROON

Global Health Systems Solutions (GHSS) is an international non-governmental organization created in 2010. It has as vision to strengthen health systems, services and networks in developing countries, and to conduct operational research to support healthcare programmes. The organization collaborates with the Cameroon Ministry of Public Health in: raising awareness and consciousness on health and health-related issues, donating medical equipment and resources to health facilities, carrying out health screening and vaccinations in communities. GHSS has recorded some significant achievements in its primary health care interventions in Cameroon:

- 417338 persons educated on sexual & reproductive health through home visits, community surveys and outreach sessions within the community.
- Persons provided with sexual & reproductive services.

 These include the distribution of condoms, emergency contraceptives, identification and linkage to care for cases of teenage pregnancies, gender-based violence, Sexually Transmitted Infections (STIs), and unvaccinated children.
 - men (40 years +) screened for prostate-specific antigen in health facilities in the South West Region of Cameroon.
- Health Care Worker (HCW) from 443 health facilities within 12 African countries trained on SARS CoV-2Ag RDT
- 340 persons screened for Hepatitis B and C in Douala
